

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **AKSHAN ENTERPRISES LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **5C Gerald Street, Lincoln** and known as "SUPER LIQUOR LINCOLN", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises. The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS – SECTION 116 (2)

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold, supplied or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day.
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold, supplied or delivered on the following days and during the following hours while the premises are operating as a bottlestore:
- Monday to Sunday from 9.00am to 9.00pm**
- (c) Water shall be freely available to customer while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (f) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
- Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted 22 February 2023.
- (g) The following step must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
- The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their Host Responsibility Policy aimed at promoting the reasonable consumption of alcohol.
- (h) No alcohol of the following types is to be sold or supplied under this licence:
- No single sales of RTD's, cider or beer but excluding craft beer, can made in containers less than 500mls, including from damaged packaging;
 - No single sales of RTD's or cider greater than 7% abv;
 - No single sales of beer, other than craft beer, greater than 7%abv.
- (i) Outward facing advertising in respect of premises windows is limited to on A3 or two A4 sized sheets of paper.
- (j) Signage on the footpath outside the premises is limited to one sign, perhaps rotating.
- (k) The entire bottlestore shall be designated as **Supervised**.

Conditions applying to any remote sales for the sale and supply of alcohol:

- (l) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
- The licence holders name, the licence number, and the date on which the licence expires.
 - A legible image of the licence or a clearly identified link to such image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- (m) The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
- In the case of an order made using an internet site – the prospective buyer must declare by ticking an on-screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where the prospective receiver is involved that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over);
 - once, when the prospective buyer first commences the order process; and
 - again, immediately before the sale of alcohol is completed
- (n) In the case of any internet form, telephone order or physical order form, unless the prospective buyer has by declaring, or by ticking, or by signing the relevant age declarations that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where any prospective receiver is involved, has declared, ticked or signed that the prospective receiver is 18 years of age or over), the procedure is to refuse to sell alcohol to that prospective buyer.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

Section 214 – Manager to be on duty at all time and responsible for compliance.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises situated at 5C Gerald Street, Lincoln are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee on the 22nd February 2023.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Gerald Street is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either -
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements above, **the licence expires on the 22nd day of April 2026**, unless again renewed.

NOTE: This licence replaces the licence number 59/OFF/099/2020 issued by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee.
