Sections 17 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), <u>ADAMS FAMILY ENTERPRISES</u>
<u>LIMITED</u> (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at 10 Wood Street, Mangawhai Heads, Kaipara District and known as "Super Liquor Mangawhai" to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before
 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday, 9.00 am to 10.00 pm.

- (c) A potable drinking water supply is to be freely available to all customers at all times that the premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. "Freely available" to customers in relation to water
 - Supplied free in clean drinking vessels on request; or
 - (ii) Available free in larger containers from which it may be easily poured or drawn by customers, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby; or
 - (iii) Available free from a tap to which customers have easy access, together with clean drinking

vessels that are also freely available nearby.

- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (e) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
