OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Kiw-e Onerahi Limited is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 1 Onerahi Road, Onerahi, Whangarei, and known as "Onerahi Super Liguor", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Subject to condition 3, alcohol may be sold on, and delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm.

- 2. No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Dav.
- 3. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time, on any day. Any alcohol sold by remote sale must not be delivered at any time between 11.00 pm and 6.00 am the following day.
- 4. For any remote sale, the licensee must comply with the requirements in the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 for signage and to ensure that the purchaser is not a minor.
- 5. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- 6. The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area.
- 7. The Licensee must have available for consumption off the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 8. A properly appointed Certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- 9. The Licensee must display at the premises:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons:
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol:
 - A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each C. principal entrance.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises is situated 1 Onerahi Road, Onerahi, Whangarei is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Whangarei District Licensing Committee on 13 December 2018.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be attached to the inside of the premises concerned so as to be easily read by people entering the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance. DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

(a) either-

- until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or (i)
- if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but (ii)
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
- until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or (i)

if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued. (ii)
